### Grammar points:

Remember the difference between **is** (singular) and **are** (plural) and the adjective that follows will need to change depending on whether it is **singular** or **plural, masculine** or **feminine**.

Remember there are two different words you can use for 'people' in Spanish, but one of the words is always feminine and never changes into a plural if it is talking about more than one person!
