**3. The following 3 sentences are written in English, and use some of the words that appeared in exercise 1. Translate the sentences into Spanish**

- The destruction of the wetland is alarming.
- The wetland is home to lots of animals and plants.
- There are many species in danger of extinction.

**Grammar points:**

Remember that the word 'lots' in Spanish changes its spelling to reflect whether the word it is describing is masculine (*mucho*) or feminine (*mucha*); it also has plural forms (*muchos / muchas*).

Remember in Spanish we use exactly the same word (*hay*) for 'There is' and 'There are'.
